# What is Respect Life Sunday?

The history of Respect Life Sunday dates back to 1972, when the U.S. bishops started a respect life program in October, in anticipation of the Roe vs. Wade decision by the U.S. Supreme Court in January 1973.

Halton Alive has supported parishes in observing the first weekend of October as Respect Life Weekend for over a decade, providing churches with materials to help Catholics understand and value the gift of human life and help build a culture that cherishes and protects it.
